Zonta Club of Madison is part of Zonta International, a global organization of executives and professionals working together to build a better world for women and girls. Through service and advocacy projects, fund-raising, community grants, scholarships, and networking with community partners, we work to empower women and girls locally and, through Zonta International projects, worldwide.

Together with other Zonta Clubs worldwide, we work toward the Zonta Vision of a world in which women's rights are recognized as human rights and every woman is able to achieve her full potential. In such a world, women have access to all resources and are represented in decision-making positions on an equal basis with men. In such a world, no woman lives in fear of violence.



In 2019-20, Zonta International celebrated the 100th anniversary of the founding of Zonta in Buffalo, New York. Today, there are over 1,100 Zonta clubs in 62 countries, and over 27,000 Zonta International members working together to achieve that Vision. Zonta Club of Madison was founded in 1940.
